Timothy Davis was designated the Director, Security Policy and Oversight, under the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence, on May 9th, 2011. He is responsible for the development, coordination, and overseeing the implementation of DoD policy, programs, and guidance for Industrial, Information, Personnel, Physical, SCI and SAP Security, as well as Insider Threat Program, and critical program information protection, for the DoD and cleared contractors in the National Industrial Security Program.

Mr. Davis retired from the United States Air Force in August 2007. He entered the Air Force in 1971, and served as a personnel specialist, honorably discharged in the rank of "Buck Sergeant" in 1975. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in 1979 and was assigned to the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI). He was a commander at all levels and retired as the AFOSI Region 3 (Wing level), Commander, Scott AFB, IL where he was responsible for all AFOSI activities and personnel supporting three war fighting unified commands; three USAF Major Commands; the Pentagon, the SECDEF, Air Staff, and two DoD agencies. He has held staff positions at AFOSI intermediate headquarters, and headquarters, HAF, and SAF. Many of his earlier assignments related to special agent duties, including assignments as the Regional Forensic Consultant for the Rocky Mountain Region, Lowry AFB, CO and the Pacific Region, Clark AB, Republic of the Philippines. His overseas assignments also include tours in Turkey, Japan, and Afghanistan.

Mr. Davis most recently served as the Security Director, HAF, Director of Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance, A2Z, where he was responsible for providing direction/guidance and management oversight for information, industrial, and personnel security programs for the USAF A2 enterprise.

Mr. Davis holds a BA degree in Forensic Studies, Indiana University, Bloomington, IN, a Masters of Forensic Science and a Fellowship in Forensic Pathology from The George Washington University, Washington, DC and The Armed Forces Institute of Pathology, respectively.
